THE STAFF AT EHS CONTINUES TO BE ENCOURAGED BY THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS THAT COMPLETE GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS. THE 2014-2015 SCHOOL YEAR SAW FORTY-TWO STUDENTS GRADUATE WITH HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMAS. THE FORTY-TWO GRADUATES WERE THE SECOND HIGHEST TOTAL SINCE THE 2011-2012 SCHOOL YEAR.

EHS, MUCH LIKE THE REST OF THE NATION, HAD TO PREPARE FOR AND TAKE A VARIETY OF STANDARDIZED TESTS. THE EHS TEAM, LED BY MS. AMY RING, MR. IAN FREDLUND, MS. MEGAN CANTY, MR. JASON NOSTRANT, AND MR. MATT TANGUAY, GUIDED STUDENTS THROUGH THE ANNUAL ACT AND WORK KEYS TESTS IN MARCH AND THE NEW STATE OF MICHIGAN M-STEP TEST IN APRIL. OTHER FORMAL ASSESSMENTS THAT WERE USED TO GAUGE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT WERE THE NWEA TESTS IN THE FALL AND SPRING AND THE DECOMMISSIONED ACT TEST.
