- State of Michigan law requires a minimum of 5 fire drills, 2 tornado drills and 3 lockdown drills.
- Three of the fire drills are to be held in the fall and two during the remainder of the year.
- One tornado drill must be held during the month of March
- One lockdown drill by December 1; and at least one after January 1
- One drill during lunch, recess or other
- Teachers are reminded to remove attendance books when vacating building.
- When each Safety Drill is finished, send completed forms to Matthew Dishman – Facilities and Transportation and Jackie Miracle - Educational Service Center, within five days of completing drill. Maintain a copy for your records.
